We opened our doors in 2020. We have served 161 men and currently on track to house 42 residents this year.

HEART

King David is known as "a man after God's own heart." That is at the core of our ministry. Regardless of challenges, we seek God's heart and follow His will.

GOLIATH

We see our men face, and overcome, giants in their lives. Things that seem easy to some folks can be huge obstacles for someone in recovery. Something like getting a driver license and vehicle insurance is a giant.

Similarly to David, our men have often experienced turmoil and conflict with their families. Through our family-like structure, counseling, healing, and encouragement, we see our men reconnect with healthy relationships.

The Next Chapter

We now see our men overcome addiction and do the hard work that is necessary to live out their sobriety goals, only to find themselves unable to find safe affordable housing. Through prayer, God presented a solution. He led us to a dilapidated apartment complex just a mile away, that with some love and attention, will be the home of our graduates. WHAT IS A GRADUATE?

Graduates are men who have completed a recovery program and have proven they are ready for the next step. Each man will be responsible for rent and continue with recovery classes. He will also provide sweat equity in the apartment construction and ongoing maintenance and care.

What are we building: We are rehabbing a dilapidated apartment complex located in Plymouth. There will be four apartments housing eight David's Courage graduate men.

Why are we building: There is a housing crisis in Marshall County and it greatly impacts our graduates. Men who have proven they want to live out their sobriety goals are finding it almost impossible to obtain appropriate housing.
